



## JOHOR JUNIOR OPEN (MIXED) CHAMPIOPSHIP 2022

### TERMS OF COMPETITION

#### Management

1. The **JOHOR JUNIOR OPEN (MIXED) CHAMPIONSHIP 2022** (hereinafter referred to as the “Championship”) shall be managed by a Competition Committee (hereinafter referred to as the “Committee”) whose decision on all matters shall be final.

#### Venue & Date

2. The competition will be played on **15<sup>th</sup> - 17<sup>th</sup> November 2022**  
Venue: **IOI Palm Villa Golf & Country Club, Kulai . Johor**

#### Schedule of Play

3. The schedule of play shall be as follow:
  - 3.1 Monday (14<sup>th</sup> November 2022) - Practice Round  
@7:30am, last tee off at 12:00 noon
  - 3.2 Tuesday (15<sup>th</sup> November 2022) - Day 1 Tournament @8:00am
  - 3.3 Wednesday (16<sup>th</sup> November 2022) - Day 2 Tournament @8:00am
  - 3.4 Thursday (17<sup>th</sup> November 2022) - Day 3 Final Round @8:00am

#### Format of Play (MIXED FORMAT OF 54 HOLES EVENT)

4. The tournament shall be decided by Strokeplay over 3 rounds of 18 holes each day. In the event of circumstances which make the playing of **54 holes** impracticable, to cancel any round or rounds is subject to Committees’ discretion.
5. The boys will play from their own set of tees, and the girls will play from their own set of tees based on the category.  
Division A: age 16-18 (born in the year 2004, 2005 & 2006)  
Division B: age 12-15(born in the year 2007, 2008, 2009 & 2010)
6. The Championship is based on **GROSS** Score. There shall be a cut-off after 36 holes at which only the top 60% and ties leading players shall advance to the final round depending on the number of participants at the discretion of Organizing Committee.
7. The tournament winner will be the player, boy or girl, in their respective Division A and B with the lowest combined gross score over the 3 rounds of the tournament shall be the Johor Junior Open (Mixed) Championship Champion player of the year 2022.
8. Flight arrangement for the Championship shall be decided by the Committee, mixing boys and girls either in two (2) tee starts, four (4) tee starts and or shot-gun starts at the discretion of the organizing committee.



9. Flight arrangement for the Championship shall be organized according to respective age group division, either threesome, or two boys and two girls in the same group and to be played from their respective own set of teeing area.

Tournament Registration

10. Registration for the Championship begins at 7:00am on 14<sup>th</sup> November 2022 (Practice Round Day) at IOI Palm Villa Golf & Country Club lobby.
11. Official practice round is on 14<sup>th</sup> November 2022 (Monday) from 7:30am onwards and last tee off will be 12:30 noon. All players must leave the course by 4:00 pm. Players are to book the tee time for practice round directly with the club at least 5 days in advance and to make payment of RM 75.00 inclusive of green fee and buggy fee directly to the club.

Draw and Starting Time

12. The committee will make the draws and the starting times for all the rounds which will be posted at the clubhouse lobby (next to registration counter). Such posting will be considered sufficient notice for information and distribution. The committee reserves the right to vary the starting times, at its absolute discretion, before tee off.

Eligibility

13. The championship is open to **BOYS & GIRLS** who are Amateur Golfers in accordance with the Rules of Amateur Status as approved by the R&A Rules Limited.
- 13.1 Age minimum 12 years old and maximum 18 years old with birth years between 2004 - 2010.
- 13.2 There will be **two** Division of the championship:
- a) 12-15 years old mixed boys and girls
  - b) 16-18 years old mixed boys and girls

Course Yardage By Category

14. The Committee has the absolute discretion to change the age group's division, the teeing areas and course yardages as deemed fit.

Div	Gender	Age	Year of Birth	Max. H'cap Index	Course Yardage
A	Boys	16 – 18 yrs	2004 – 2006	18	6,400 – 6,600 yards
A	Girls	16 – 18 yrs	2004 – 2006	24	5,400 – 5,600 yards
B	Boys	12 - 15 yrs	2007 - 2010	18	5,500 - 6,200 yards
B	Girls	12 – 15 yrs	2007 – 2010	24	4,800 – 5,200 yards

Note: The Organizing Committee may, as its discretion, to accept entry of player/s without the W.H.S index but it must be certified by either the club Captain, or club Manager or coach.



### Entries & Closing date

15. **RM 250.00** (Ringgit Malaysia Two Hundred and Fifty only) for both local and foreign players – Inclusive of green fee, insurance, light daily breakfast and lunch on prize presentation day.

**Closing date: 11<sup>th</sup> November 2022**

The Committee reserves the right to accept late entries or refuse any entry at its absolute discretion without assigning any reason for the refusal. The Committee will only accept up to **80 players**.

### Rules of Play

16. All play shall be in accordance with the rule of Golf as approved by the R&A Rules Ltd and their interpretations as contained in the Official Guide on the Rules of Golf, these Terms of Competition and the Local Rules of IOI Palm Villa Golf & Country Club and any additional Local Rules as approved by the Championship Committee.

### Caddies

17. Parent/Coach/ guardian is allowed to **caddie for players playing in BOTH Division A & B category**. Players are encouraged to bring their own trolley/caddies. Trolley/Caddies from the club are limited and are based on first come first serve basis.

### Conforming Ball (Rule 4.2a)

18. In making each stroke, a player must use a ball that conforms to the requirement in the Equipment Rules.

**Penalty for making a stroke in breach of Rule 4.2a: DISQUALIFICATION**

### Conforming Clubs (Rule 4.1a)

19. Any driver the player uses to make a stroke must have a club head, identified by model and loft, which is on the current list of conforming driver heads issued by R&A.

**Penalty for making a stroke with a club in breach of this Local Rule: DISQUALIFICATION**

### Distance Measuring Device (DMD)

20. Players are **ALLOWED TO USE** distance measuring device (DMD) to obtain distance only. Players must turn off the slope and elevation function on the device and strictly comply to R&A **RULE 4.3a**

### Undue Delay

21. No unnecessary delay. Coaching during rounds should be minimize, this is to avoid slow play.

### Suspension of play due to a dangerous situation (Rule 5.7)

22. A suspension of play for a dangerous situation will be signaled by one prolonged note of siren. All other suspensions will be signaled by three consecutive notes of the siren. In either case, resumption of play will be signaled by two short notes of siren.



### Scorecards

23. All **Competitors must submit** their respective scorecard duly signed and counter signed by his marker as soon as possible after the completion of each round and in any event, it **shall not be later than 10 minutes after the completion of each round.**

**A score card is deemed to be submitted the moment the competitor leaves the scoring area.**

### Decision On Ties

24. a) In the event of a tie for 1<sup>st</sup> place, the players tying shall as soon as possible continue to play-off, from hole 9 or 18 or any holes as decided by the committee of their respective course, repeatedly until a winner is decided. The purpose of the play-off is to decide the **Champion**. In the event of inclement weather or any unwanted obstacles that prevent the play-off, the committees' decision to determine the winner is final.

b) In the event of a tie for any other place, the tie shall be decided by On Count Back (OCB) in the following order:

- i. Last 18 holes
- ii. 2<sup>nd</sup> 18 holes
- iii. Last 9 holes (holes 10 – 18)
- iv. Last 6 holes (holes 13 – 18)
- v. Last 3 holes (holes 15 – 18)
- vi. And finally, the last hole (hole 18)
- vii. If the tie is still undecided, it shall be decided by lot.

Note: The last 9 holes (back nine) shall always refer to holes 10-18 on the scorecard of the IOI Palm Villa Golf & Country Club.

### Prizes

25. Top five on both Division A & B. The number of prizes may be changed depending on the final entries.

### Result Of The Championship – Championship Closed

26. The championship shall be deemed to have closed when the trophy/Prizes have been presented to the winner.

### Ruling by Referees and Committee (Rule 20.2)

27. The Committee ruling is final.

### Standards Of Player Conduct (Rules 1.2)

28. The following may be considered "Serious Breaches of Standard of Player Conduct" for this championship:-

- i. Usage of handphone during play to the annoyance and distraction of other player(s).
- ii. Verbal abuse of fellow Competitor/Official/Staff



- iii. Intentionally distracting or offending fellow competitor(s)
- iv. Improper conduct such as swearing and throwing of golf clubs.
- v. Players and caddies smoking/Vaping on the golf course

\*Note: Any other serious breaches not listed above will be dealt with by the committee on individual basis.

**Penalty for a serious breach of standards of player conduct: DISQUALIFICATION**

Indemnity/liabilities

29. The Committee, The Sponsor, The Organizers or The Club will not be responsible for any loss, damaged, harm, infected with any viruses or any form of injuries that the participant of the Championship may suffer as a result of their participation in this championship.

Capture and Use of Images

30. Participants may be filmed and photographed and may film and photograph, during the championship. By signing the entry form, participant agree to be filmed, photographed, televised or otherwise recorded during the championship, and that captured or recorded image, together with the name, may be used in any content, format and through any media or technology whether now existing or created in the future, by the organizing committee during or after the championship in perpetuity in relation to the celebration and promotion of the game of golf in a non-commercial manner.
