







## **Notice to Players (Additional information / Revised TOC)**

Final - 15/11/2022 (3:35pm)

- 1. Players have to report at starter **10min** prior to tee time
- 2. All players are encouraged to play READY GOLF (in the safe and responsible manner)
- 3. Motorized Transportation
  - a. Caddy (parent/relative/coach/club hired caddy) are allowed to either walk or ride on a buggy at RM106 (Single rider) or RM53 (Twin sharing), to be paid directly to Club. However all players MUST NOT ride on any form of motorized transportation except as authorized or later approved by the committee.
  - b. Club caddy can be hired by pre-booked at office on first come first serve basis at RM84.80nett, to be paid to the Club directly.

Penalty for Breach of Local Rule: The player gets the **general penalty (two strokes)** for each hole during which there is a breach of Local Rule. If the breach occurs between play of two holes, it applies to the next hole.

Note: A player who will play, or has played, under penalty of stroke and distance is always authorized to ride on any motorized transportation.

- c. Buggy strictly on the track/buggy path.
- 4. Evacuation plan all players are advise to move to the nearest Shelters
  - ~ IOI Course Hole 2(rain shelter) and hole 5 (halfway hut)
  - ~ Palm Course Hole 12 (rain shelter) and hole 16 (halfway hut)
- 5. Teeing area:

Boys A (16 – 18 years) - BLUE TEE

Girls A (16 – 18 years) - RED TEE

Boys B (11 – 15 years) - WHITE TEE

Girls B (11 – 15 years) - YELLOW TEE

- 6. Use of distances measuring device (DMD) Rule 4.3a(1)- Players are allowed to use such instrument for measuring distance only
- 7. To speed up play, below are the situation, whereby players are permitted to ride on buggy:
  - a. from Clubhouse area to 1st and 10th tee
  - b. from 9th green to 10<sup>th</sup> tee
  - c. from 18<sup>th</sup> green to 1<sup>st</sup> tee
  - d. from 13<sup>th</sup> green to 14<sup>th</sup> tee

## **NOTICE TO ALL PLAYERS**

#### SUSPENSION OF PLAY DUE TO BAD WEATHER

**ALL PLAYERS** are advise to move to the nearest SHELTERS as follows:

### IOI COURSE (Hole 1-9)

HOLE 2 (rain shelter)
HOLE 5 (halfway hut)

## PALM COURSE (Hole 10 – 18)

HOLE 12 (rain shelter) HOLE 16 (halfway hut)

The following siren signals will be used to suspend and resume play (Rule 5.7)

A. Immediate stop - 1 prolonged note of the siren

B. Normal stop - 3 consecutive notes of the siren (series 10 second)

C. Resume play - 2 short notes of the siren

If a player fails to discontinue play under (A. immediate stop), he/she is **DISQUALIFIED**, unless circumstances warrant waiving the penalty as provided in Rule 5.7b

# **LOCAL RULES**

This copy of the Local Rules will supersede the one printed at the back of the score card

#### 1. OUT OF BOUNDS (RULE 18.2a)

- On and beyond all walls or fences and hedges bounding the Course
- White Line or stakes demarcating the Out of Bounds

#### 2. PENALTY AREAS (RULE 17)

• Penalty areas are defined by Yellow stakes / Yellow lines and Red stakes / Red Lines

#### 3. DROPPING ZONES

• As an additional relief option, Dropping Zone is provided at hole 16 (Par 3).

#### 4. MOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS (RULE 15.2)

• distance markers, Yellow/Red stakes and roping stakes are movable obstruction

#### 5. ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITIONS (RULE 16.1)

- a) Ground Under Repair
  - All areas bounded by white paint in the general areas
  - Washed-down crevices in the bunkers
  - GUR marked on Green #15, player may play the ball as it lies, or proceed under rule 16.1 without penalty

#### b) Immovable Obstructions

- Buggy tracks and earthen service roads, drainage sumps, metal covers, sprinkler heads, valve covers and electrical boxes
- Protective netting (fence) located at the left of hole 10
- Concrete drain adjacent to buggy path left of hole 11

# SPECTATOR GUIDE TO JOHOR JUNIOR OPEN (MIXED) CHAMPIONSHIP 2022

- NO ADVICE to be given to any player during the tournament rounds.
- PLEASE AVOID ALL COMMUNICATIONS, verbal and non-verbal, which may constructed by others (competitors, parents and our referees) as advice.
- PLEASE KEEP A DISCTANCE of 30yards or more from players while following them during play.
- DO NOT WALK into general area of the course, putting greens or teeing areas during tournament rounds
- Spectators are STRICTLY bound to walk on the cart path only.
- Help us to keep pace of play by assisting to SPOT GOLF BALLS FOR PLAYERS.
- AVOID DISTRACTING COMPETITORS at all times on the golf course.
- PLEASE REFRAIN FROM bringing handphones, cameras or radios onto the golf course. If you bring your handphone with you, please switch it to silent mode.

#### PARENTS' CODE OF CONDUCT

The JOHOR JUNIOR OPEN (MIXED) CHAMPIONSHIP 2022 takes great pride in the calibre of play, player conduct and parent dedication displayed at all our events. In order to maintain the fun and professional atmosphere, as well as show respect for the involvement of our host clubs and their volunteers, JOHOR JUNIOR OPEN (MIXED) CHAMPIONSHIP 2022 requires that all participants, spectators and parents (and their guests) adhere to set of guidelines known as the Code of Conduct. The Code of Conduct is to be observed at all our events.

#### REGARDING THE RULES OF GOLF

- Only Referees are allowed to administer ruling. You will be bought into situation ONLY if the Referees ask you.
- Encourage your child to familiarise himself/herself with the Rules of Golf and the supplementary Local Rules specific to the tournament so that they are aware of the options available to them.

#### RESPECTING THE HOST CLUB AND GOLF ETIQUETTE

- Familiarise yourself and adhere to the host facility's dress code. Some facilities may not allow blue jeans, T-shirt, etc.
- If you are going to wear golf shoes as you walk the buggy track, make sure they do not have metal or traditionally designed spike.

#### AFTER THE TOURNAMENT

We welcome any and all suggestion for JOHOR JUNIOR OPEN (MIXED) CHAMPIONSHIP 2022 to us that will ultimately help us make these events even more special for all involved. Feel free to include comments you may have about JOHOR JUNIOR OPEN (MIXED) CHAMPIONSHIP 2022 with regards to the development of junior golf in Malaysia.

#### SOCIAL MEDIA & MASS MAILING

- If there is any shortcoming in a completed/on-going tournament, you are encouraged to raise your concern/grievance with the Organising Committee and/or Tournament Committee in writing. All written complaints shall be handled by the Committee accordingly.
- But if you choose not to observe the proper channel to raise any grievance and turn to social media or mass mailing as your channel, the Committee may have to take appropriate actions to curb this practise and protect the image of the organisation which includes disqualification of your child in future events.

#### TOURNAMENT WHATSAPP GROUP

- The JOHOR JUNIOR OPEN (MIXED) CHAMPIONSHIP 2022 will use Whatsapp as a platform for quick information dissemination.
- The JOHOR JUNIOR OPEN (MIXED) CHAMPIONSHIP 2022 will form a Whatsapp Group, consisting of players and their parents as members of this group. The purpose is for The JOHOR JUNIOR OPEN (MIXED) CHAMPIONSHIP 2022 to disseminate tournament information to the players and for the players/parents to ask questions on tournament related matters.
- The Whatsapp Group should be solely used for tournament related matters and group members should refrain from posting the followings;
  - o Birthday or congratulatory messages to individuals.
  - Responding with 'NOTED', 'Thank you', etc to postings by the JOHOR JUNIOR OPEN (MIXED) CHAMPIONSHIP 2022, as it is assumed that once a message is posted into the group, everyone in he group has received the message.
  - o Posting marketing/sales advertisments.
  - o Posting politically related, religiously inclined, sexual or inappropriate articles.

This will remove clutter from the chat group, making easier for everyone to refer to the essential tournament information.
